The monument known as Midhowe Broch, broch and settlement, Rousay comprises an Iron Age defended settlement centred upon a broch and including a number of houses, all situated upon a promontory protected by a ditch and stout masonry work. The area to be scheduled is that enclosed within the fence and wall which define the area in care, and bounded on most of the seaward side by a modern sea-wall. It measures a maximum of 95m NW-SE by 43m, to include the broch, outer works and houses. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rousay and the County of Orkney as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and


