for any interest they may have as owners or otherwise of the Monument known as the Market Cross situated within a railed enclosure in the centre of the main street of Ormiston 230 yards west-south-west of the east end of said street, 80 yards east-north-east of the junction of said street with the road leading in a general southerly direction to Ormiston Hall Lodge, and 320 yards north by west of the Tyne Water at its nearest point being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the solum of the Main Street, Ormiston, situated in the Parish of Ormiston and County of East Lothian.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

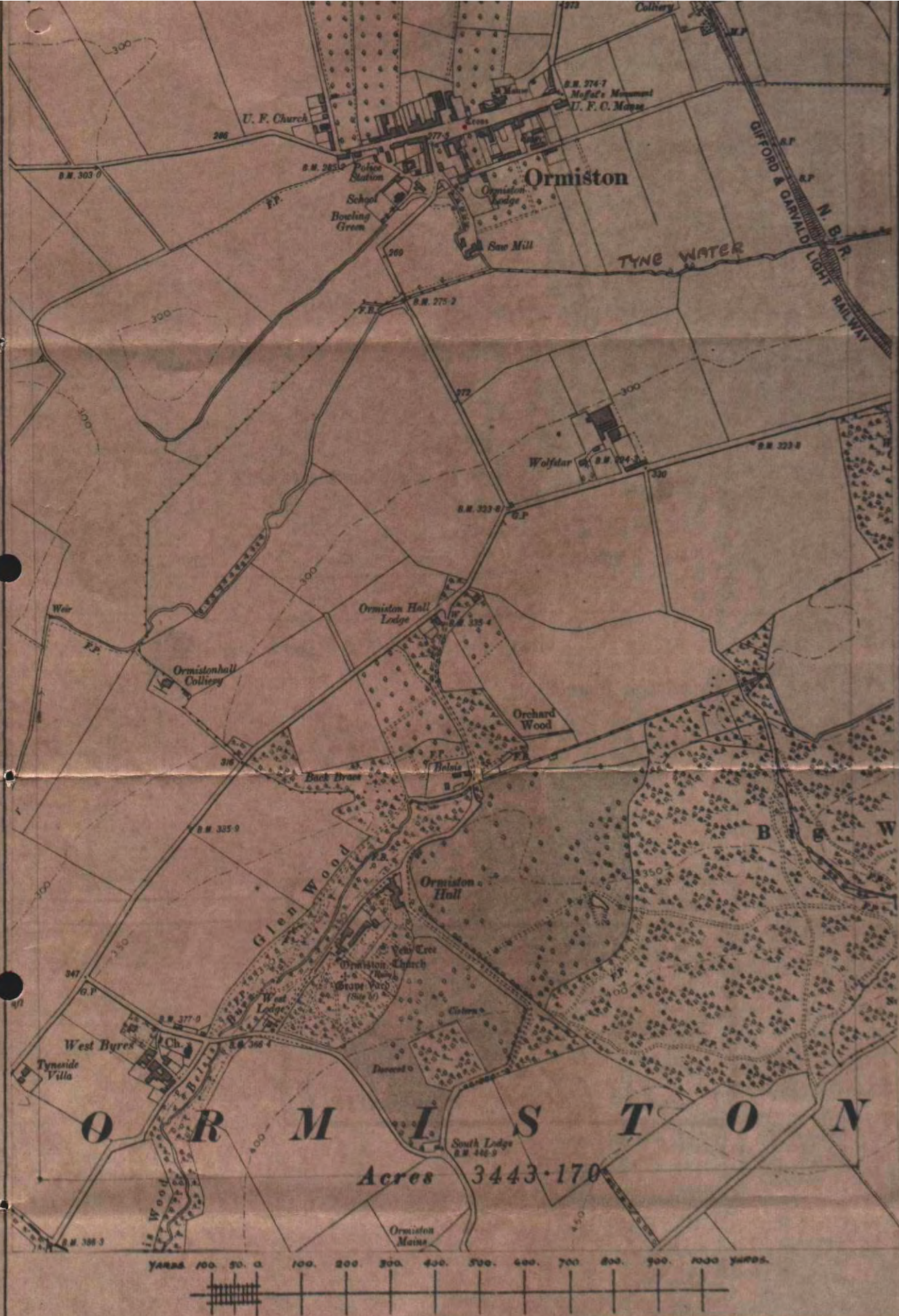
