

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Torrylin, chambered long cairn 610m SW of comprises a neolithic chambered long cairn of the Clyde Group which is situated on the edge of a raised beach terrace to the E of the Torrylin Water. The area to be scheduled measures up to 50m from NNW to SSE by 40m transversely, to include the cairn and an area around in which associated remains may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmory and the County of Bute as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto




