Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument clearance for the works detailed below, subject to the attached condition:

Condition referred to above:

1. Not less than 2 weeks before any of the works to which this clearance relates are begun on site, Historic Environment Scotland will be informed in writing of a detailed timetable/scheme of works for the proposed works.

Reason: to ensure that Historic Environment Scotland is aware of the timing of the works and to enable monitoring of the progress of the works if required.

Reasons for the Decision:

Subject to compliance with the schedule of conditions, the works proposed are considered acceptable in meeting the terms of national policy for scheduled monuments, and also accounting for other material considerations.
