HM are aware of the theft of the lead wallhead capping and the proposal for replacing with SIKA for previous site visits. Conservator's report details required conservation of the lettered/carved frieze which is periodic maintenance works.

Replace stolen lead wallhead capping with SIKA liquid membrane. Undertake periodic conservator repairs to carved frieze.

5 Description of proposed works

Replace stolen lead wallhead capping with SIKA liquid membrane. Lead detailing from original scheme (drawing excerpt attached of original approved lead detailing) to be reinstated and SIKA only to be used where not visible (except from distant view from round tower).

Wallhead capping works to be undertaken whilst scaffold is in place for conservators to attend to failing conservator repairs to the lettered inscription.
