Mowing machine carrying out regular damage to the stones in Old Cullicudden, including Medieval cross stone "A" seen on path; it is raining, and the rain exposure since these stones were recorded by RCAHMS has also caused serious deterioration.

The Kirkmichael Trust visited Alness kirkyard on 14 August 2016 to view a memorial (the Master John Fraser memorial Canmore SC 400215) that has similar features to one at Kirkmichael (the Urquhart of Braelangwell memorial). It had been photographed by RCAHMS in, we believe, the 1950s or 1960s. We were concerned to see that weather exposure had resulted in almost complete loss of features, and the Trust is determined that the same should not happen with the Resolis stones in Kirkmichael and Old Cullicudden.
