Installation of railings to the wall walk stairs leading from the garden to the casemates

5 Description of proposed works

To address known risks of falls from height onto a hard standing, a new set of railings are proposed to provide the necessary edge protection to the stair. Railings are to be traditionally made and based on an existing design on the site. Railings will be fixed into mortar joints and a single support pad foundation is required to provide support at the base of the railings. An archaeological watching brief will be provided when excavating for the pad foundation, upon agreement of a written scheme of investigation.
