Prior to conservation the graveslab (in two parts) lay unsecured against the north wall of the Nave. At previous Annual Monument Audits we discussed the return and display of the conserved graveslab and explored the option of laying it flat, but this could suffer physical damage especially given the use of the Church for weddings. The option of enclosing the graveslab within a timber box was eventually thought to be too much of a visual intervention within the Church setting. It was therefore agreed we would look again at reinstating the slab in a vertical position, and the proposed location was chosen as it has no carved features on the wall-face that would be obscured whilst also offering mortar joints that are wide enough to allow fixings to be inserted without damage to the neighbouring stone.

5 Description of proposed works

It is proposed to install the two parts of the graveslab in a vertical position on the east wall of the N Transept. It will be retained in place by purpose made non-ferrous clamps padded with foam carefully fixed into existing masonry joints by HES MCU and supported at the base by an oak block (details as shown on the attached drawing DC-GS-01). All work will be carried out by HES Applied Conservation Unit in conjunction with HES Masons.
