Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument consent for the works detailed below, subject to the attached conditions.

Consented Works:

- a) Archaeological evaluation (via two test pits) and monitoring of all works within the relevant section of scheduled area
- b) Removal of existing trees and vegetation
- c) Sheet piling to canal bank
- d) Creation of a footpath on canal bank
- e) Regrading of the existing canal bank
- f) Removal of an existing pontoon
- g) Construction of a pontoon mooring
- h) Soft landscaping between the footpath and the canal bank

Conditions referred to above

1. Not less than 2 weeks before any of the works to which this consent relates are begun on site, Historic Environment Scotland shall be informed in writing of the timetable for the proposed works. Historic Environment Scotland shall be informed in writing of any changes to the timetable prior to the works being carried out.

Reason: to enable a representative of Historic Environment Scotland to monitor the works in progress.

2. Within 3 months of the end of fieldwork the applicant shall submit to Historic Environment Scotland a Data Structure Report (as defined in Historic Scotland 1996 Project Design, Implementation and Archiving. Historic Scotland Archaeological Procedures Paper 2). This shall also be copied to the Sites and Monuments Record of the City of Edinburgh Council.

Reason: to enable Historic Environment Scotland to monitor the progress of the work which is subject to consent and to ensure that a written record of the archaeological work is presented in an accessible form.

Reasons for the Decision:

Subject to compliance with the schedule of conditions, the works proposed are considered acceptable in meeting the terms of national policy for scheduled monuments, and also accounting for other material considerations.
