Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument consent for the works detailed below without conditions.

## **Consented Works:**

- a) Consolidation of the carved stone inscription and surrounding architectural ornament and mouldings on the south façade, using the updated scope and methodology set out in the document of 19 January 2017. For clarity, this does not include any indents or replacement of damaged or missing letters.
- b) Consolidation of the corbelling of the Oriel window on the South Tower, using the updated scope and methodology set out in the document of 19 January 2017.
