### 4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)

Repair + Conservation of East Range of Rosslyn Castle including ground works and adjustment of ground level to allow scaffold erection.

### **5** Description of proposed works

A full repair and conservation project is underway for the A-listed East Range of Rosslyn Castle with planning, listed building consent and scheduled monument consent approval. The works which require further SMC involve ground works to ensure scaffolding can be erected on a level base capable of bearing high loads from the scaffolding. Ground works include: a light scrape of the ground, less than

300mm depth, to the south and west areas outside of the castle walls; and the levelling of a small raised area of ground which has been built up over time with organic deposits. This area will be taken back down to a stable historic ground level, approximately 1m depth. A new type 1 granular base layer will be laid to these areas to help create a stable base for the scaffold, which will be removed when the scaffolding is dismantled. Existing soil will be reinstated to existing levels. No excavation is required to the north of the castle, however a ground membrane will be laid over the exitsing ground surface with type 1 hardcore, which will be removed along with the scaffolding. The majority of work to the north is within an area of ground to be built up to form new access (approved previously by SMC 300057042), any ground outwith this area will be reinstated to existing levels. The extents of groundworks have been confirmed by preliminary scaffold design, provided by the appointed scaffold sub-contractor.
