4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)

Replacement of existing fuel tanks on St Kilda

5 Description of proposed works

Removal and replacement of all 9 existing fuel tanks on St Kilda. A mechanical survey of the structural integrity of the existing fuel tanks was carried out and it was recommended that all 9 be replaced. To ensure a safe environment, some have been emptied and others have been reduced in capacity, but failure to rectify the situation will cause a direct environmental and operational threat to St Kilda. Three fuel tanks are to be removed and replaced this year, with the remaining 6 replaced in early 2016. The fuel tanks themselves are excluded from the scheduling, however, a temporary crane which will be used to remove and replace the tanks is to be positioned on the scheduled area. In

addition, temporary heras fencing will be erected on the scheduled area, to prevent livestock entering the area of works. Please see the attached 'Method Statement' which describes the works in detail.
