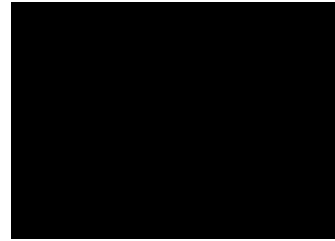

#### METHOD STATEMENT

#### REPOSITIONING OF MEDIEVAL CROSS AT KILMUN

#### DESCRIPTION

The task involves moving historic grave stones from the graveyard to a mounting inside the church.

#### MOVING STONE

1. Place plywood sheets to form pathway
2. Gently clear round edges to ascertain thickness and place softening to protect
3. Gently lift recumbent stone with levers or by hand if possible
4. Lift onto trolley or pallet truck
5. Move along pathway into church
6. Fix in desired position on plinth in stone with stainless steel bracket and neoprene packing

NB The exact position and preferred way of fixing will have to be discussed and agreed prior to moving the stone as bracket requires to be manufactured accordingly. Due to the varying shapes and sizes of stones it will be necessary to alter this method slightly to suit but we have used this method successfully to move similar stones and statues in the past.
