Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument consent for the works detailed below, subject to the attached conditions.

Consented Works:

- a) Removal of wooden overhead line poles and associated fittings

as described in your application dated 20 October and the following supporting documents:

- 1) Newstead, Oakendean: plan showing poles to be removed
- 2) Newstead, Broomhill Spur: plan showing poles to be removed

Conditions referred to above

1. The electricity poles shall be cut off at ground level and the stump left in situ to rot. No disturbance shall be caused to the ground surface or to buried archaeological deposits during this operation.

Reason: to ensure that ground disturbance that might damage archaeological deposits does not occur.

Reasons for the Decision:

Subject to compliance with the schedule of conditions, the works proposed are considered acceptable in meeting in the terms national policy for scheduled monuments, and also accounting for other material considerations.
