Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument consent for the works detailed below, subject to the attached conditions.

Consented Works:

- a) Access improvements at the monument to include:
1. installation of a replacement gate and associated works giving access to the Stones of Stenness
 2. installation of a new style of gate and associated works giving access to Barnhouse.

- 2) Works locations and construction details
- 3) Written Scheme of Investigation (WSI)

Conditions referred to above

1. Two weeks after completion of the works on site, the applicant will provide photographs of the work area, before, during and after the works, to Historic Environment Scotland's Heritage Management Directorate.
