Drainage and maintenance works at Dalmuir (Railway) Tunnels

5 Description of proposed works

The tunnels comprise of twin bore brick-lined tunnels 78metres long running under the Forth and Clyde Canal. Network Rail has included physical works within the tunnel for 2016. The works are required to improve the current drainage system and ensure the tunnels are effectively drained, and to repair the water-damaged lining. The works include de-vegetation works at portals/sidewalls, refurbishment of the existing portal drainage, enhancement of overall drainage system up to the

pumping station and general lining repairs/ grout injection throughout the tunnels.
