**4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)**

Access is required over the Caledonian Canal Scheduled Ancient Monument to allow the 33kv connection for Glen Buck Hydro Electric Station.

**5 Description of proposed works**

To carry out the overhead line modifications which are outwith the Scheduled Area, we need to take low ground pressure tracked machinery along the towpath of the canal bank with the vehicles driving off the canal bank to the ground which the overhead line occupies. Underground 33kv cable will also have to be drilled below two sections of the Scheduled Area, below the approach to Bridge of Oich and below the Canal itself. Method statements and maps are attached.
