Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument clearance for the works detailed below, subject to the attached conditions:

Consented Works:

- a) Conversion of the Casemates, Building 22, into Armouries

As described in your application dated 16 November 2015, and the following supporting documents:

- 1) Existing and dountakings plan
- 2) Proposed layout plan
- 3) Proposed sections and details
- 4) Door and window details
- 5) Proposed drainage

Conditions referred to above:

1. Upon removal of the stud wall, the applicant will stop work and inspect the masonry for any historic plaster with a representative of Historic Environment Scotland. Should any historic plaster be found, an agreed method statement for the retention and recording of the plaster will be sent to Historic Environment Scotland in writing for approval.

Reason: to ensure that the potential adverse impact on any historic fabric is minimised, and that an accurate record of works to the monument is maintained.

Reasons for the Decision:

Subject to compliance with the schedule of conditions, the works proposed are considered acceptable in meeting the terms of national policy for scheduled monuments, and also accounting for other material considerations.
