4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)

Landscaping and improvement works from Viewforth Bridge to Gibson Terrace, Union Canal Edinburgh

5 Description of proposed works

There are seven elements to this work detailed on a separate covering letter.

1. Upgrade current towpath with granite setts, in keeping with newly laid setts within the Boroughmuir School grounds.
2. Removal of barrier gates and speed humps from the towpath.
3. Reduce side walls of redundant canal abstraction point under towpath to reach formation level for new towpath granite setts.

4. Excavate and install in advance of towpath upgrade two 100mm ducts to future proof for the provision of later services.
5. Installation of mooring rings.
6. Installation of LED lights along the length of the newly upgraded towpath. Excluding under the historic bridges, and not within the historic fabric of the canal. Installation of two towpath recessed uplighters to illuminate crests either side of Viewforth bridge.
7. Removal of graffiti from Viewforth Bridge.
