<p>The towpath on the north side of the Caledonian Canal, to the east of the Caledonian Canal Maintenance Team Depot (see Location Plan) is proposed to be surfaced with bitumen macadem. This will extend the existing surfaced towpath to the start of the new Dochgarroch (east) to Sornum footpath/cycle track that was formed in 2014/2015.</p> <p>This Sustrans funded project is aimed at improving the running surface for walkers & cyclists, and extending the existing bitmac surfacing to meet the start of the new Dochgarroch (east) to Sornum footpath/cycle track.</p>
