Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument consent for the works detailed below, subject to the attached condition.

Consented Works:

- a) Installation of a new lectern mounted A1 sized interpretation board

as described in your application dated 14 December 2015 and the following supporting documents:

- 1) Scheduled area plan (30 July 1998)
- 2) Signage schedule (16 September 2015)
- 3) Assessment of archaeological sensitivity (18 September 2015)
- 4) Lectern details (A4 sheet)

Conditions referred to above

1. No work requiring scheduled monument consent shall take place within the scheduled area until the applicant has secured the initiation of a programme of archaeological work in accordance with a Written Scheme of Investigation approved in writing by Historic Environment Scotland (a Project Design). This scheme of works shall be fully implemented during the course of the approved development.

Reason: to ensure that archaeological information is recovered and recorded to a satisfactory standard.

Reasons for the Decision:

Subject to compliance with the schedule of conditions, the works proposed are considered acceptable in meeting the terms of national policy for scheduled monuments, and also accounting for other material considerations.
