**Methodology:**

1. All trees identified by City of Edinburgh Council as being infected by Dutch Elm disease to be removed - section felled (5, 6, 20, 46 & 47) or clear felled (19) - by certified arboricultural contractor or by experienced HS staff.
2. Disc section of each tree to be retained for dendro-chronological testing.
3. All timber suitable for re-use to be planked on site and removed Galgael Trust.
4. All head wood, bark, twigs and smaller branches to be chipped on site then removed to suitable disposal site (to be burnt or disposed of as agreed with City of Edinburgh Council's arboricultural officer).
5. Stumps to be cut to 100mm above ground level, debarked and left to decay naturally.
