5 Description of proposed works

Change of specification from soft type 1 compacted stone to hard surfaced towpath by introducing Dense Bitumen MacAdam (DBM) and top dressing with 6mm stone chips.
Width of towpath 2.2 metres on non vehicular section and 3.5 metres on section to be used by agricultural plant.
Methodology has been used over the last 10 years with great success for the 2.2 metre wide.
