4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)
Removal of vegetation and the repair of kingswells Consumption Dyke

5 Description of proposed works
Remove unwanted vegetation that have grown very close to and on the dyke, by cutting of trees and then dispose outwith the schedule area. Ecoplugs will be inserted in stumps of trees to prevent regrowth. Repair the entire wall length of Dyke as shown on attachment ACC003, by re-attaching stones that have fallen off the dyke, make the stairs at both sides of the Consumption dyke entranceway visible

and tidy up the surrounding of the entire wall length.

Following the dyker's recommendation as shown on his quotation(attachment ACC002), we are proposing the use of occasional bits of hidden mortar to secure stones especially at the Consumption dyke entranceway. Stones at this section of the dyke are vulnerable to vandalism and the dyker is not sufficiently confident that the entranceway structure of dyke will survive vandalism after repair.
