**4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)**

Installation of CCTV cameras and associated power cables.
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**5 Description of proposed works**

CCTV cameras are to be installed at 3 swing bridges in order to monitor road traffic movement.

In order to provide a power supply to the cameras we will be connecting into the canal bridge switchrooms. This will involve running a cable track (400mm width by 550mm depth) from the switchroom a distance of 44m for Laggan Swing Bridge, 34m for Aberchalder Swing Bridge and 70m for Banavie Swing Bridge. The trench will be machine excavated using a small tracked vehicle, where tracking in verge the surface will be topsoiled upon completion of works. Reinstatement of surfaces will be as existing and any spoil material will be removed off site to a suitable disposal facility.

At all three locations works will take place away from the affected structures only cabling from the more contemporary switchrooms previously installed away to the CCTV installation point.
