4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)

Construction of a new cycle friendly path from the towpath to the bottom of Bairds Brae. A new section of path - 2m wide new 'cycle friendly' whinstone setts path running E-W. Two new sett paths running NE-SW and NW-SE.

5 Description of proposed works

The elements of this work that fall within the scheduled monument are the new section of 2m wide path that runs from the towpath and across what is now a grassy knoll (East - West), and follows an existing desire line. Installation of wooden benches (no ground-breaking work involved). And the connection of the new cycle path along Bairds Brae where it joins the existing towpath. The NE-SW and NW-SE paths are either just outwith the monument or just on the edge of the monument as is re-

positioned signage.

The grassy knoll will be reduced in level to achieve the desired level for the new section of towpath, which will be at the same level as the existing historic setts. Previous ground investigations of the grassy knoll outwith the monument revealed that there were no historic setts under the grassy knoll. This is probably due to previous ground disturbance with the removal of a historic electricity pylon. The ground under the grassy knoll was disturbed soil mixed with general waste.
