New door through a previously blocked doorway at first floor level in the stair in the NE palace block at Kinneil House

**5 Description of proposed works**

**BACKGROUND:** This application follows on from the previously granted SMC for the re-opening of this previously blocked up doorway. Unfortunately when opening up it was discovered the original dressings, including the lintel, had been robbed out or damaged.

**PROPOSAL**

Although the proposal had originally been to insert a timber frame and door in the unblocked opening we now propose to supply and fix a new structural metal door frame that will support the existing

surrounding masonry (in order to minimise the intervention to the existing fabric while also carrying the new steel door which is designed to be a clearly readable as a modern addition).

We propose to replace the missing parts of the surrounding dressings with carefully cut new parts of stones on a course by course basis, so the maximum of the remaining original stones can be retained.

We also propose some freestanding timber steps to sit on the inside of the doorway to accommodate the change of level from the threshold of the new door to the existing internal landing.
