Stage 1: Borehole - Ground investigation to assess feasibility of diverting SGN high pressure pipeline across (below) canal.

5 Description of proposed works

Stage 1: Ground investigation - SGN plan to carry out ground investigations to assess the feasibility of diverting a high pressure gas pipeline from the Erskine Bridge, under the River Clyde. Stage 1 includes 12 boreholes (option for 2 more) and topographical survey of the area. SGN propose drilling one borehole (BH07) approximately 60m NE of Lock 37 of the Forth and Clyde Canal to a depth of 40m. It is anticipated that this would be approximately 35m cable percussion and 5m rotary core. Stage 2: Should to plan prove to be feasible, SGN propose installing a new high pressure gas pipeline

below the River Clyde via trenchless installation techniques. At present, the proposed depth below the bottom of the canal is 16.77m
