Replacement of existing waymarkers and installation of additional waymarkers
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5 Description of proposed works

The existing waymarkers have reached their useful life and are showing signs of wear and rot.
The proposed works are to remove the existing waymarkers and install new waymarkers that are in line with our current policy for waymarking walking routes within the National Forest Estate.

Within the SM we propose to install approximately 19 waymarkers. The posts are hand dug into the ground and shored up with the material won from the excavations. The waymarkers will avoid archaeological features and FCS have detailed knowledge of this SM through their own research and through Lidar imaging for the site. The microsting of the posts will be
