Installation of pontoon.

5 Description of proposed works

1. Installation of a new 54m pontoon, situated between existing pontoons/jetties. (See Fig 1. 'Proposed New Pontoon at Dochgarroch').
2. In order to install the pontoon a small existing wooden jetty will have to be removed.
3. There are existing concrete blocks which serve as anchors for mooring rings and these will have to be removed. They are in a degraded state and not of the correct weight and dimensions to anchor a pontoon. Once removed the excavations will be infilled and grassed over. (See Figs 2 and 3).
4. Three new excavations (2m by 1m by 1m deep) will receive three new concrete anchor blocks. The

anchor blocks will be evenly spaced along the length of the pontoon.
5. An access ramp will be fitted to the middle anchor block and the pontoon.
6. The pontoon will be attached to the anchor blocks by movable arms.
