Dear Sir

Further to our recent telephone conversation regarding the bronze plaque on the Dumbiedykes wall.

I can confirm that the method used for the erection of the plaque was as follows;

- Erect Aluminium Tower as working platform
- Set Plaque to flattest part of the wall
- Drill 4 holes to match metal supports either into Whin Stone or mortar fixing
- Fit Plaque to wall using 2 Part epoxy multihit product
- Seal plaque surround using lime mortar
- Dismantle aluminium tower
- Leave site in a clean and tidy condition

We also submit our proposed method to remove this plaque should this be necessary;

- Erect aluminium tower as working platform
- Remove lime mortar around plaque by hand chisel and hammer
- Use a cutting wheel with a metal cutting blade between plaque and wall to remove 4no metal supports
- Drill out fixings once the plaque is removed
- Fill in with a lime mortar
- Dismantle aluminium tower
- Leave site in a clean and tidy condition
