The Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979

Amended entry in the schedule of monuments

Historic Environment Scotland in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979 hereby amends the entry in the statutory schedule of monuments as set out below.

The monument known as **Clachan More, two standing stones 100m WSW of Dowally Kirk** comprises two standing stones. The monument is likely to date from the Neolithic or Bronze Age (late third or second millennium BC). It is situated on level ground on the Tummel Valley at around 60m above sea level.

The scheduled area is sub-rectangular on plan to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment is expected to survive. The scheduling specifically excludes the above-ground elements of the post-and-wire fence running south and east of the standing stones.

The monument, which lies in the Parish of Dunkeld And Dowally and the County of Perth as shown in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

This entry supersedes the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments for the monument known then as **Clachan More (Two Standing Stones), Dowally** as referred to in the Certificate of Service of Notice by the Minister of Public Buildings and Works in respect of the monument dated 17 December 1964 and recorded in the General Register of Sasines for the County of Perth on 11 January 1965.
