Installation of temporary pontoon and access ramp for an art exhibition

5 Description of proposed works

In partnership with Glasgow Sculpture Studios Scottish Canals would like to install a temporary veridock pontoon system. The pontoon would be fixed to the canal wall using bolts. The bolts will be drilled into the mortar joints of the wall and would be reversible. If HES require the bolts to be removed once the pontoon is removed this can be done and the bolt holes filled with suitable mortar. The pontoon will not affect operations or navigation but will serve as a water-side platform for a variety of exhibition material and public engagement. We envisage the pontoon to be in place for

approximately 3 months, after which it will be dismantled.
