Installation of new pontoon and associated canal-side furniture and improvements.

5 Description of proposed works

We would like to install two pontoons for residential boaters. The work includes;

1. Install 2 x 10m pontoon (joined)
2. Two anchor blocks (See Shore Fixing Details for dimensions). The excavations for the anchor blocks can be either dug by hand or with a mini-digger.
3. Installation of two new storage huts (see Storage Hut Design and Storage Hut Foundation Details)

4. Electrical distribution unit with associated ducting for services to existing pontoons (see A00543_Lock27_004 for SMC)
5. The removal of 3 trees to allow the installation of the storage huts. The trees will be cut at the base of the trunk and the remainder of the root removed with a mechanical excavator.
