

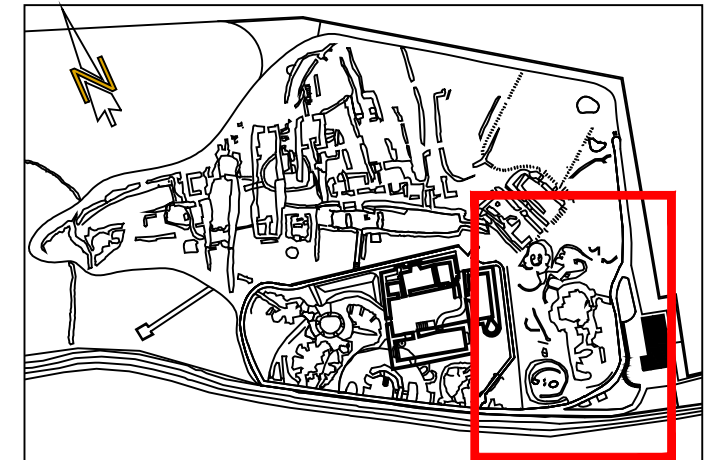


Areas outlined by dashed lines are Phase 3 Works - these areas requires further archaeological investigation and recording prior to future management being determined.

Add sign encouraging visitors to keep off grass.

**KEY**

- Maintain wall line at present, avoiding turf becoming overgrown but ensuring full turf cover.
- Full extent of wall line/feature unclear and requires turf stripping to clarify or identify extent.
- Different phases where distinction needs to be kept clear
- Wall lines where turf capping needs to be reinstated
- Exterior Paths, archaeological - Weed & Whin
- Hearth Areas - use Red Whin
- Interior Surfaces: Remove turf where present and replace with Interior Whin; retain paving where present and remove vegetation, filling voids with Interior Whin
- Area to be reburied/turf covered.
