Installation of two commeroative plaques on the Kelvin Aqueduct.

**5 Description of proposed works**

In partnership with the Institution of Civil Engineers, Scottish Canals wish to attach two plaques to the Kelvin Aqueduct. The plaques celebrate the engineering achievement of William Whitworth and Willian Gibb. The plaques are fixed by way of two dowels on the back of the plaque which will be inserted into two holes drilled into the mortar joints and filled with epoxy resin. Plaque No 1 will be fixed to the viaducts parapet wall on the towpath side. Plaque No 2 will be fixed to viaduct wall next to the Kelvin Walkway which runs below the viaduct.
