Installation of electrical supply duct under existing path, and of two site interpretation markers.

### 5 Description of proposed works

Two 7.5 metre lengths of paired 100mm diameter plastic ducts will be placed in 450mm wide trenches excavated to 600mm depth, all within the existing gravel path along the south side of the site. The two interpretation markers will comprise shaped ashlar stones, carved out to provide housing for LED flood lights, and set on in-situ concrete bases which will be cast in the ground just off to the north of the path. As shown on drawing 592-00 revision C and 592-SK01 revision A. (Additional interpretation and floodlighting works are also being proposed for the site, but these are out-with the Scheduled Site boundary).
