AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument previously known as Aiky Brae Stone Circle, Parkhouse Hill, dated 28 October 1977 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Aberdeen on 12 January 1978 and now to be known as Parkhouse Hill, stone circle (Aikey Brae), is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 60m in diameter to include the remains of the stone circle and an area around in which traces of activities associated with the construction and use of the building may survive as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

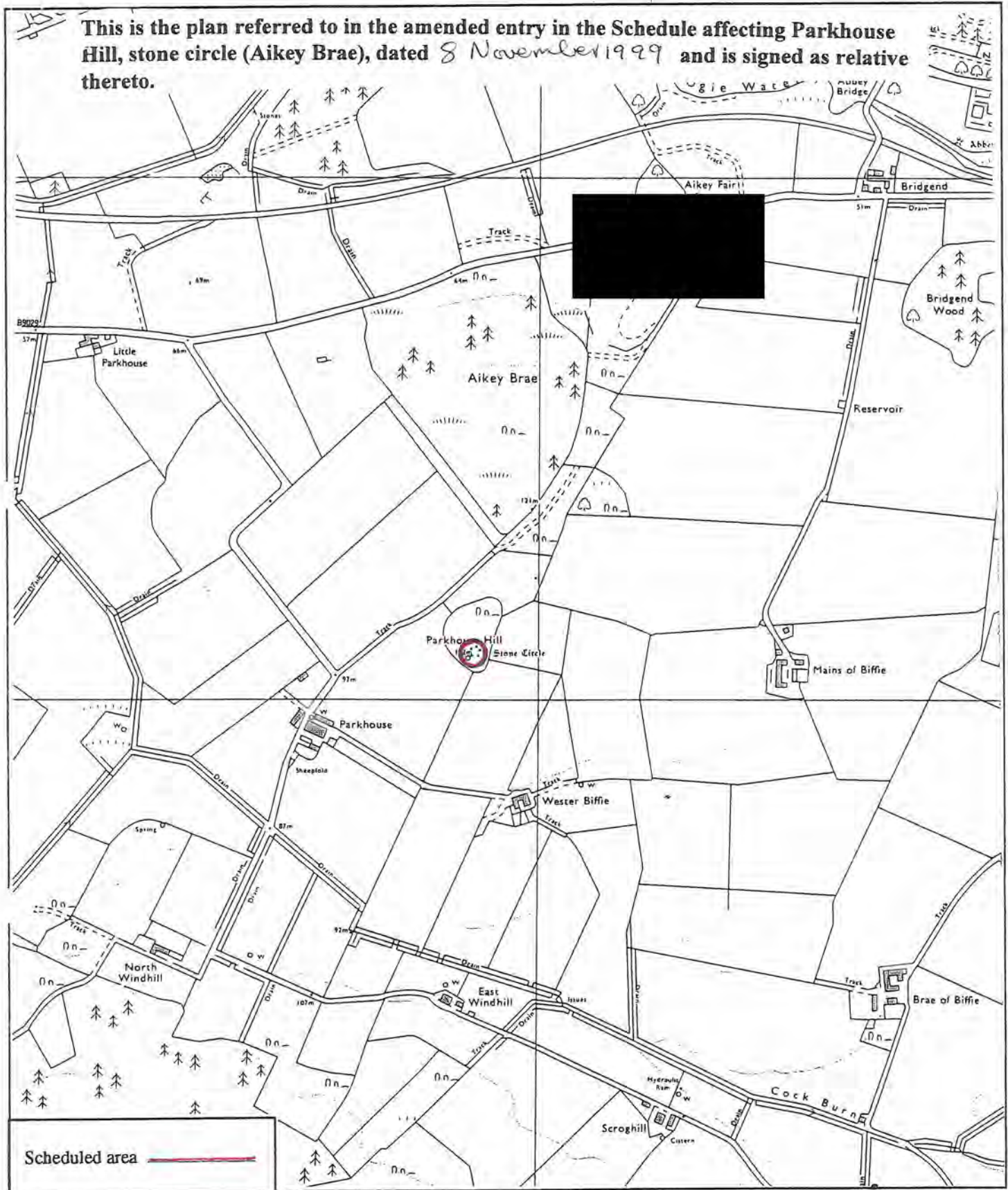
