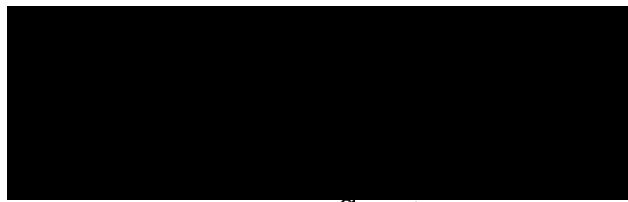
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Huntly Lodge Estates to the south of Rothiemay Railway Station,

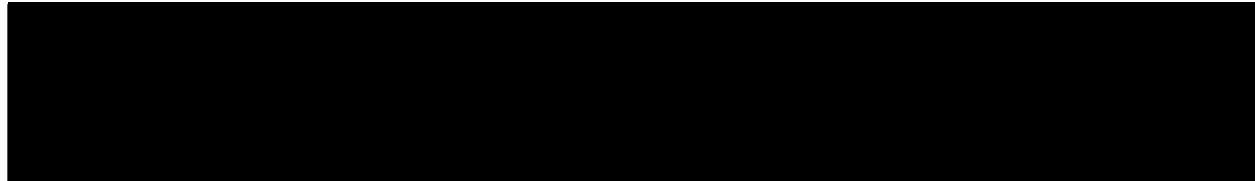

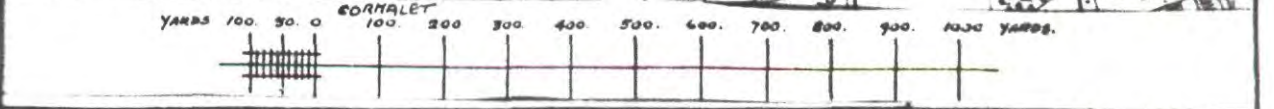
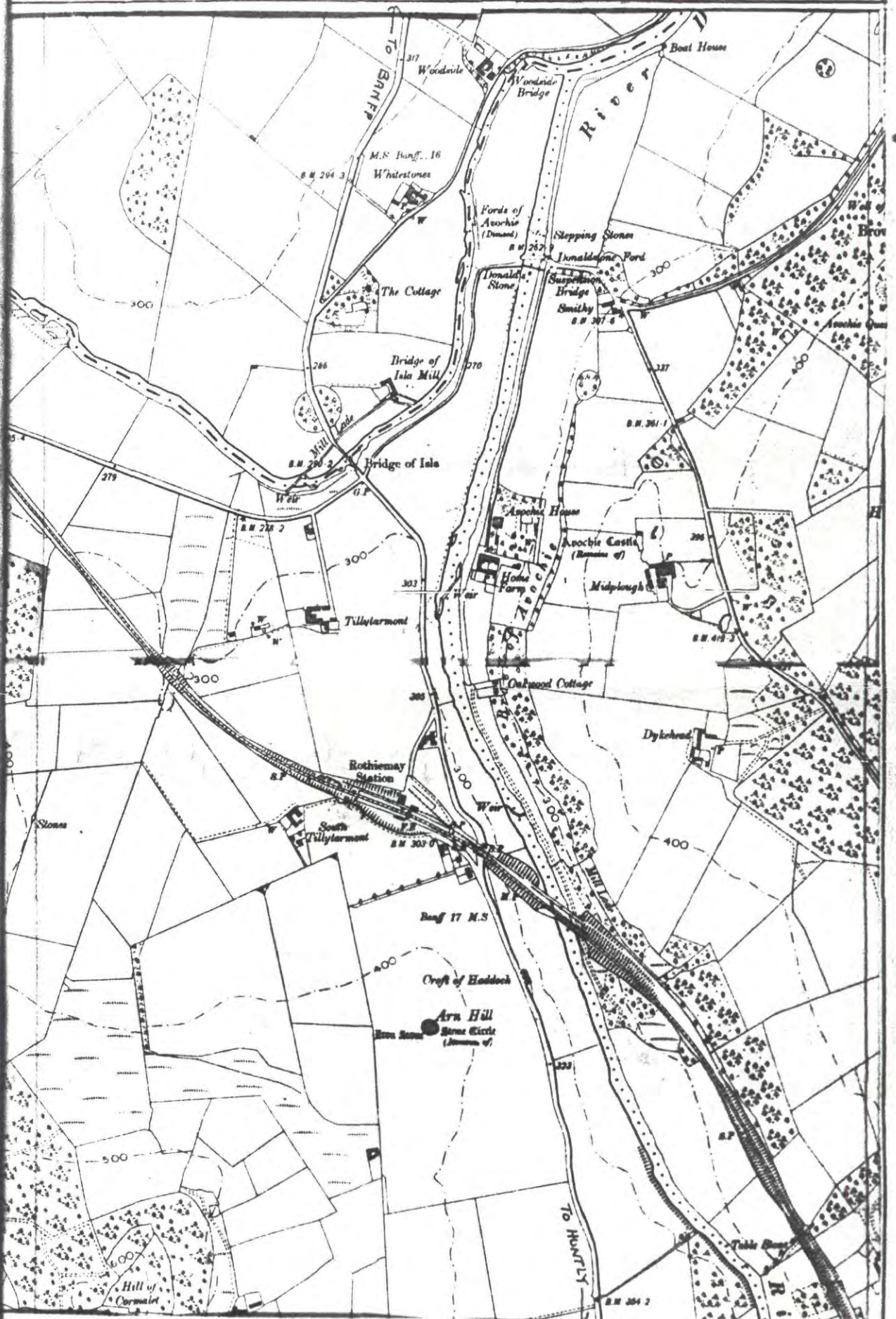
