THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931

Owners of Monument known as Stone Circle at Hatton of Ardoyne being eighty feet in diameter consisting of one recumbent stone and eight standing stones of which six are erect, one broken at base and one fallen with two inner circles slightly raised above the main circle as shown coloured red on the annexed plan and forming part of (First) the Farm and lands of Hatton of Ardoyne described in the Disposition [redacted] dated 22nd March and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Aberdeen on 11th April both in the year Nineteen hundred and fifty seven; and (Second) the Home Farm of Petmathen otherwise known as Westerton of Petmathen and others described in the Disposition [redacted] dated 27th June and 1st July and recorded in the said Division of the General Register of Sasines on 19th August all in the year Nineteen hundred and sixty nine and

situated in the Parish of Oyne and County of Aberdeen.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, as read with the Transfer of Functions (Scottish Royal Parks and Ancient Monuments) Order, 1969, the Secretary of State hereby gives notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

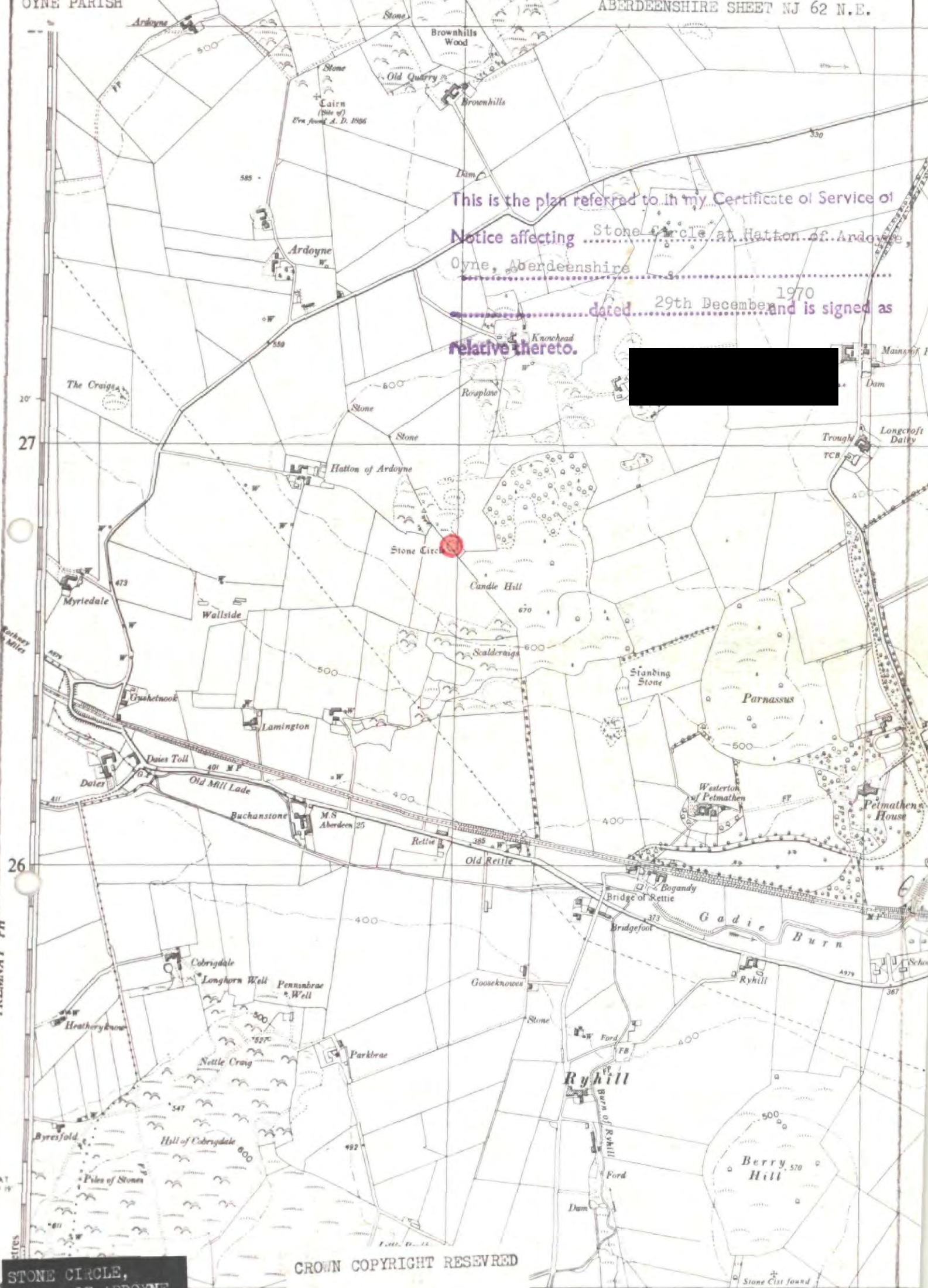
