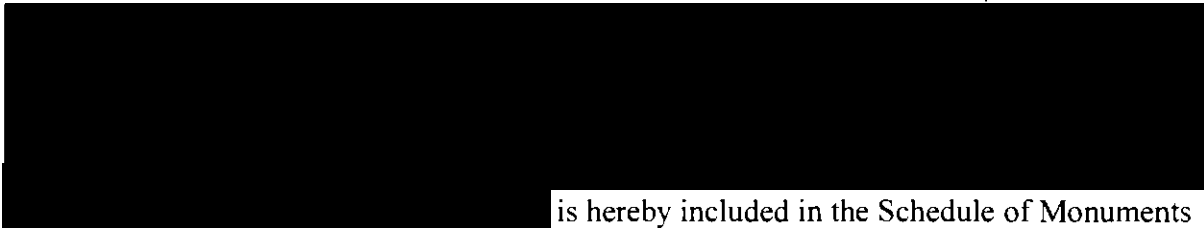

The monument known as Inschfield, stone circle 300m WNW of comprises the remains of a stone circle of prehistoric date of which only 3 stones survive; the recumbent, 13 ft 5" (4.1m) long and partly fallen; the E pillar about 10ft high; and a standing stone about 4 ft 10" (1.47m) high in the NE arc. Six stones are shown on the OS 25" map of 1868, giving a diameter of about 90 ft (27.4m). The area to be scheduled is a circle 40m in diameter centred on the centre of the circle, to include the remains of the stone circle, and an area around in which traces of activities associated with the construction and use of the monument may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Insch and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

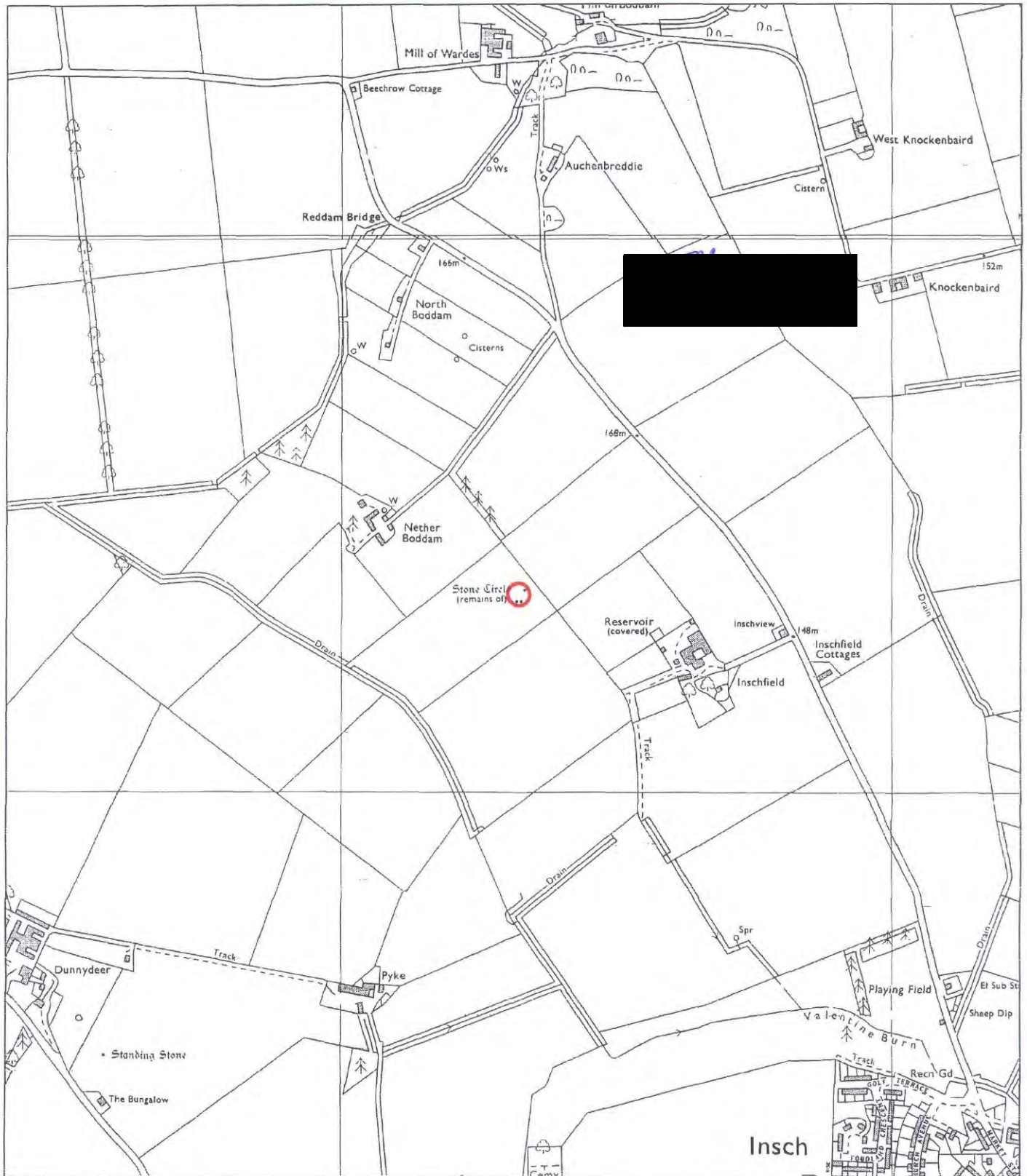
