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ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

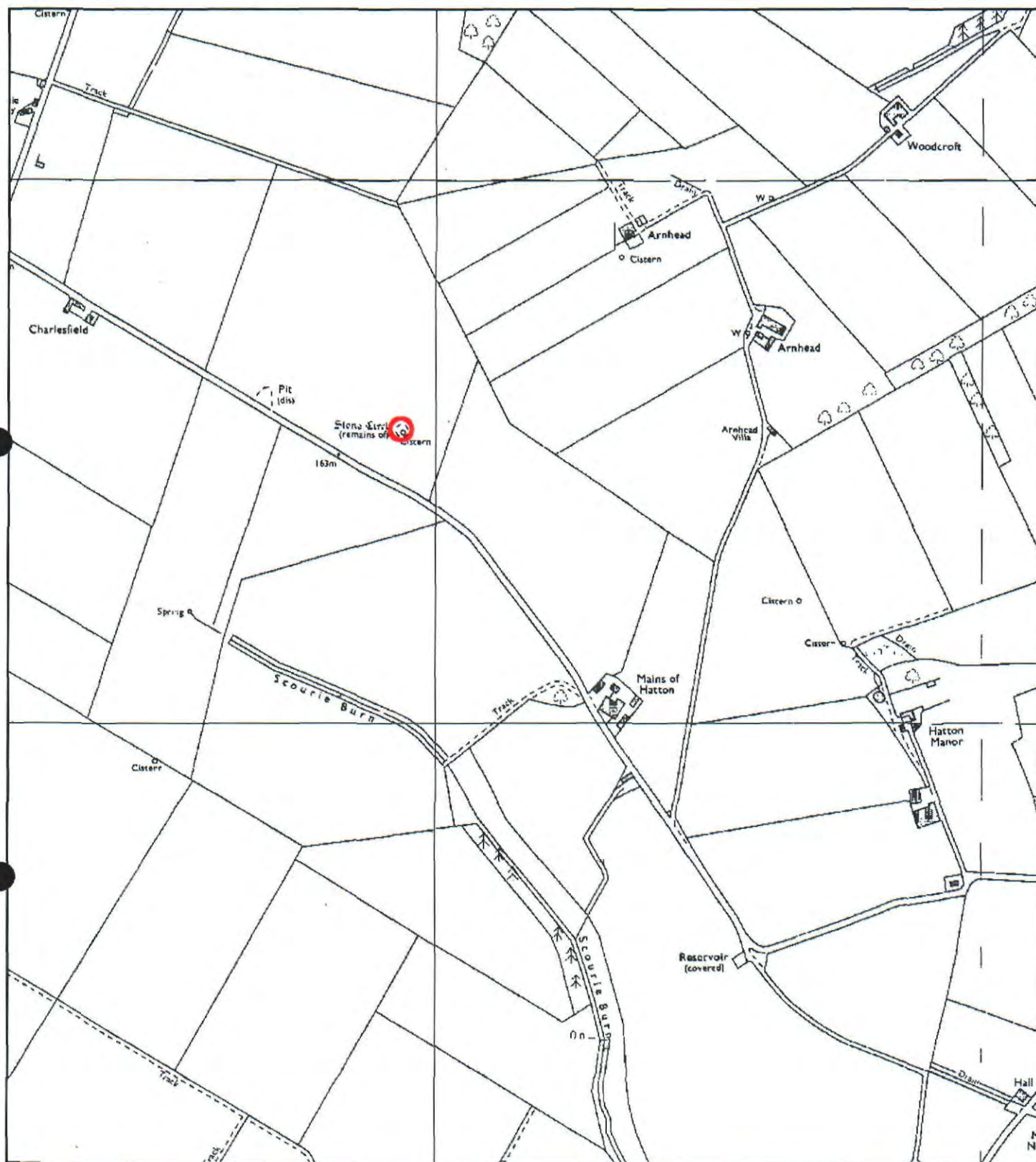
The monument known as Mains of Hatton, stone circle 575m NNW of, comprises the remains of a recumbent stone circle, situated some 575m NNW of Mains of Hatton, on the summit of a gentle hill at around 165m OD. The area to be scheduled is a circle 40m in diameter, centred on the centre of the recumbent stone circle. It includes the remains of the stone circle and an area around in which traces of activities associated with the construction and use of the monument may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Auchterless and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto
