ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Mill of Noth, standing stones 150m ENE of comprises two standing stones of prehistoric date, visible as upstanding stones. The monument is situated within pasture on a gravel terrace on the South side of the Burn of Easaiche, at about 170m OD. The standing stones stand about 3.8m apart and are set on an axis aligned roughly E-W. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to survive. It comprises two interconnecting circles, each 20m in diameter and centred on the two standing stones, forming a combined area around the stones measuring 24m ESE-WNW by 20m NNE-SSW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rhynie and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

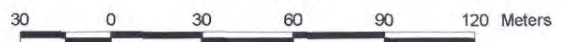
Mill of Noth, standing stones 150m ENE of
