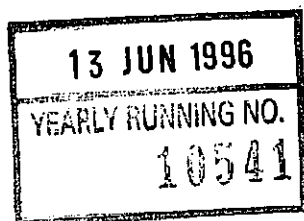

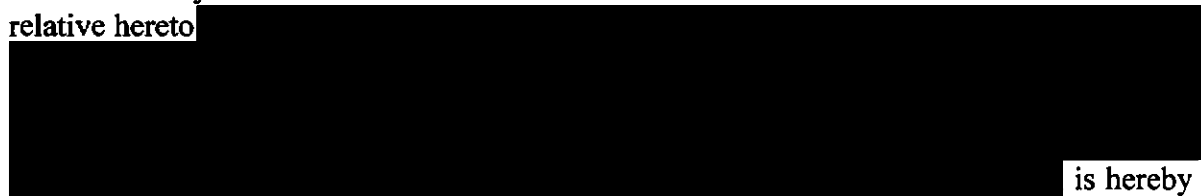

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Sunhoney, stone circle 240m NW of comprises a very well preserved recumbent stone circle, 25m in diameter, lying in an area bounded by a 19th-century plantation wall. The circle comprises 11 standing stones and the recumbent. The area to be scheduled measures 64m E-W by 58m N-S and is defined by the plantation wall, which is included in the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Midmar and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

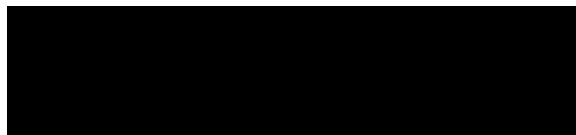

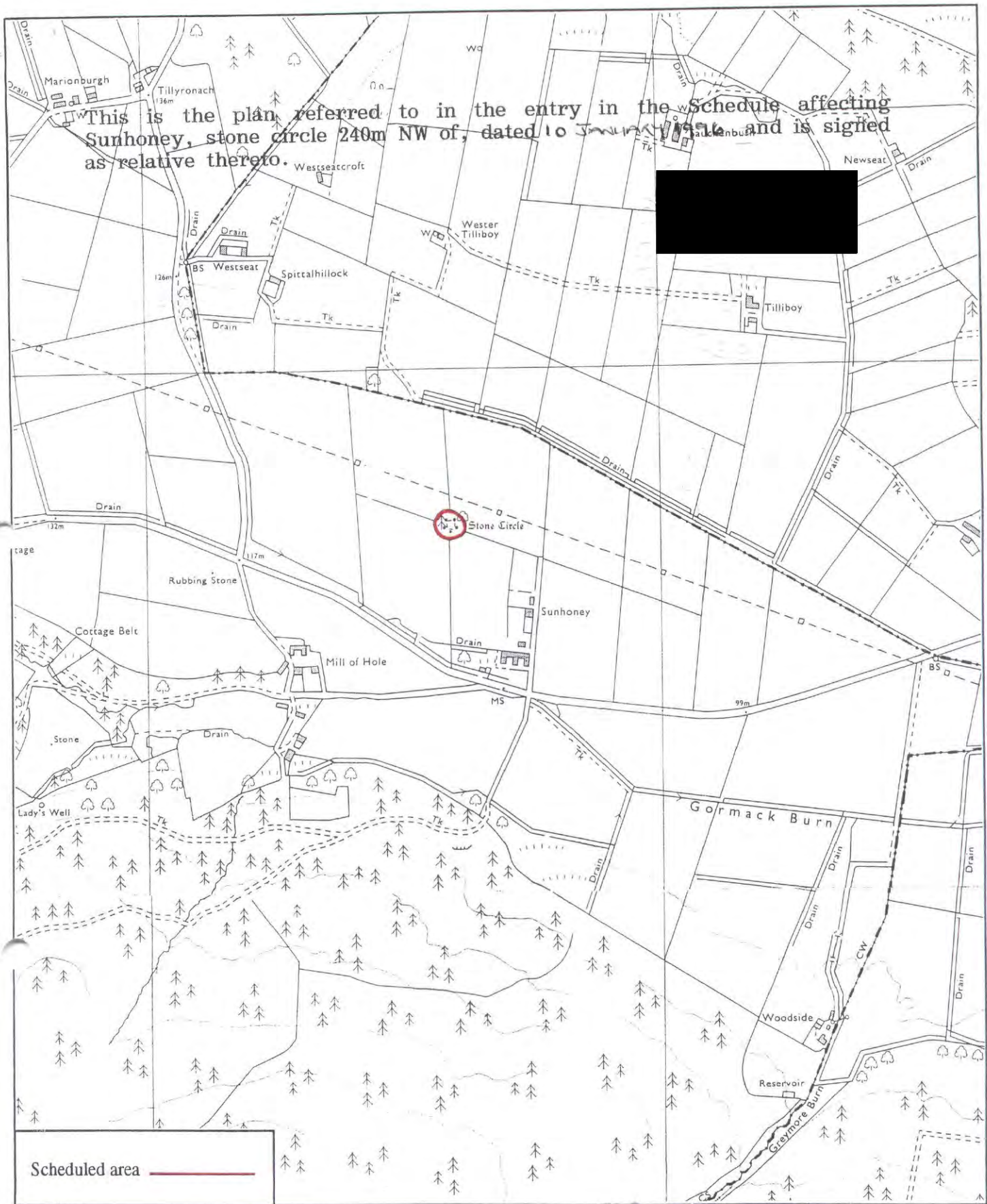

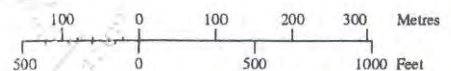
Sunhoney, stone circle 240m NW of
