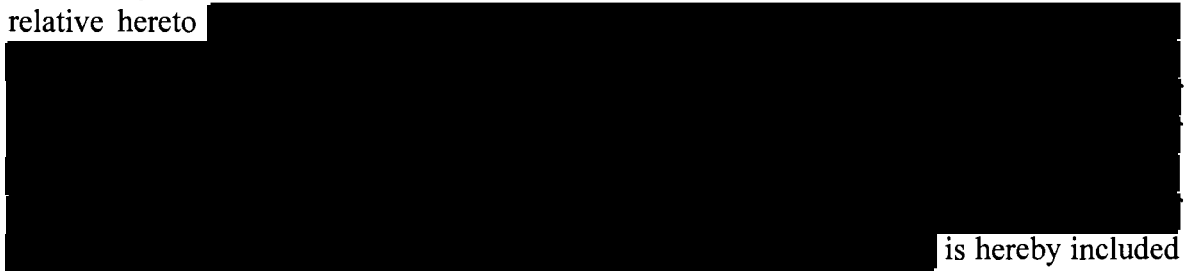


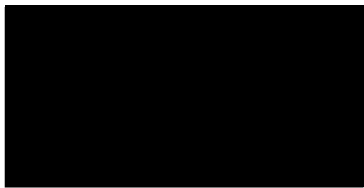
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as West Hatton Croft, long cairn 155m WNW of, comprises a well-preserved long burial cairn of the Neolithic period, which survives as an upstanding monument within the farmed landscape. The area to be scheduled is irregular, with maximum dimensions of 81m WNW-ESE by 32m N-S. The upstanding elements of the modern field walls along the S and W sides of the cairn are excluded from the scheduling to allow for routine maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Newhills and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

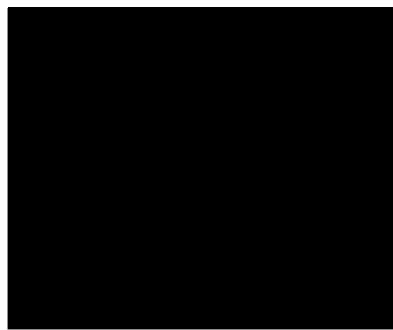




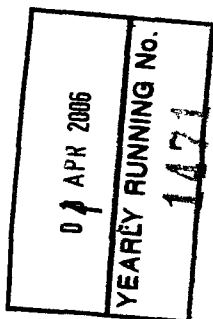
