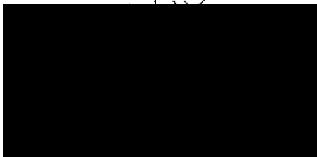

The area to be scheduled is a circle 40m in diameter, to include the visible remains of the circle and ring cairn and other features associated with their construction and use which may lie in the immediate vicinity. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Monymusk and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

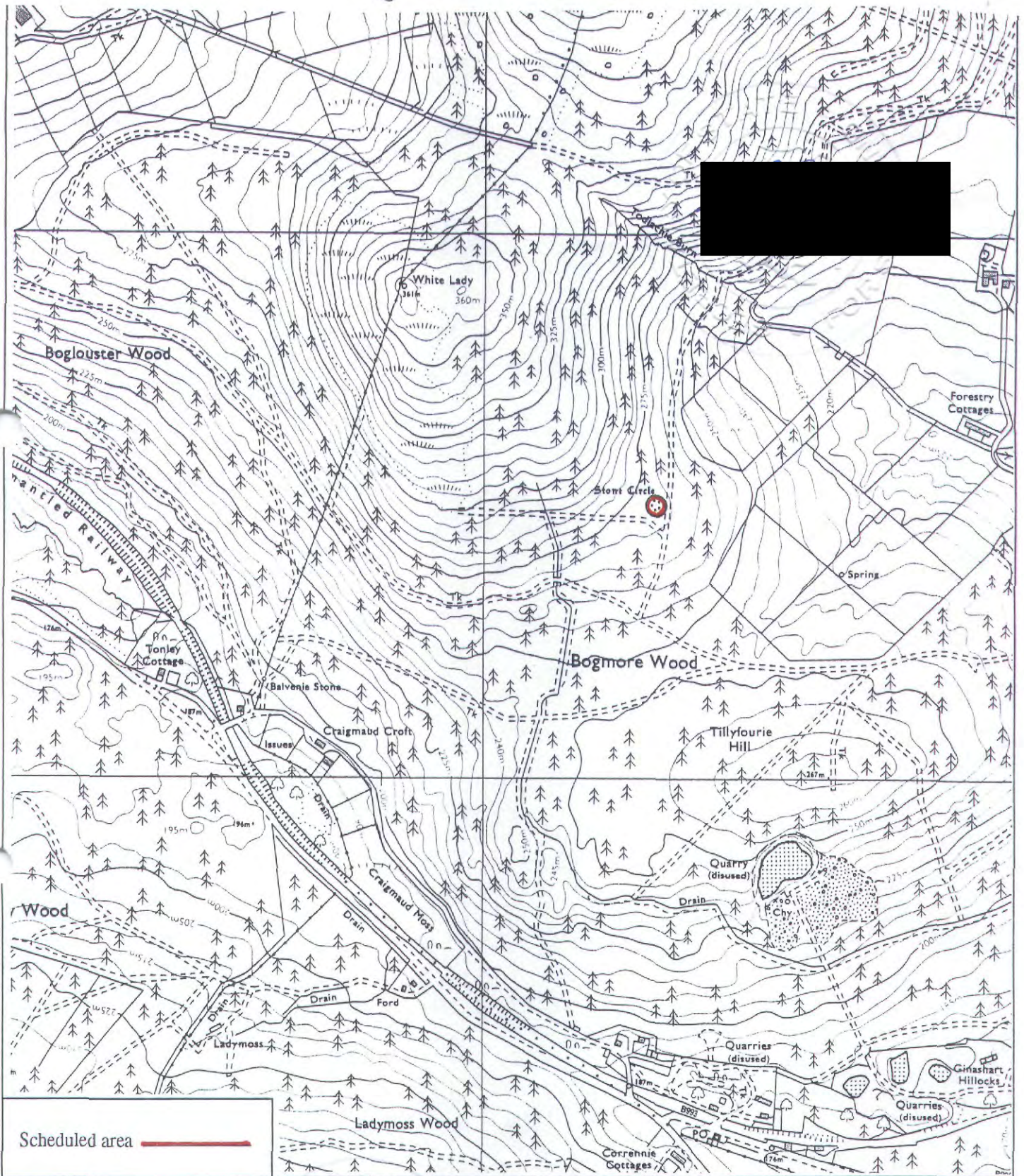


