



THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Corrachree, symbol stone 260m NW of, Tarland, comprises a Pictish symbol-incised stone. It lies in gently sloping improved pasture at 220m OD. The upright stone that bears the carvings is irregular in shape, standing 1.5m high and measuring 1.2m across its base, tapering to 0.3m wide at its point. The area to be scheduled is circular, centred on the stone, to include the remains described and an area around in which evidence relating to its erection and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Logie-Coldstone and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
