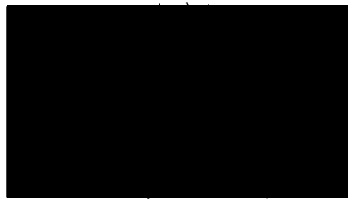

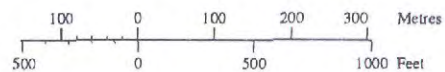
Fetterangus Church, symbol stone
