

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Huntly Market Square, symbol stone and standing stone, dated 21 March 1935 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Aberdeen on 9 April 1935 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the monument as comprising two surviving stones which stand adjacent to the N side of the base of the Duke of Richmond's statue. The eastern stone is an irregular block of whinstone (1 x 0.76 x 0.45m), decorated with an incised horse-shoe symbol, which is now virtually indistinguishable as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

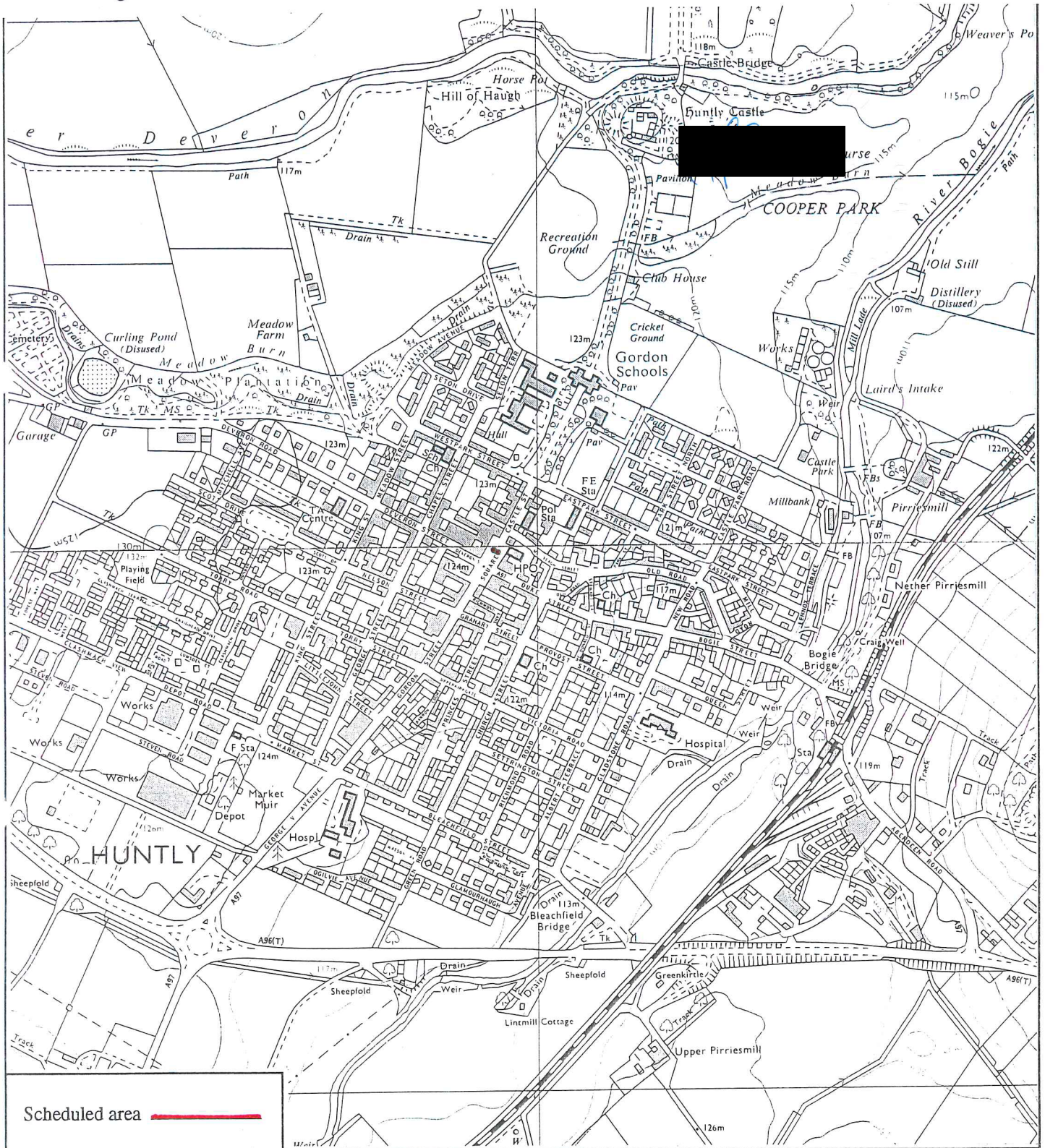

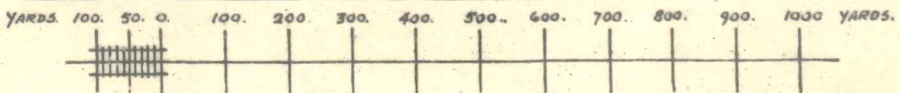

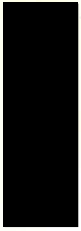
