AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as Kincardine O'Neil, old church, dated 31 March and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Aberdeen on 5 June both in the year 1936 and now to be known as Kincardine O'Neil, old church and hospital is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 75m NW-SE by about 60m due E-W as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto. Any burial lairs within the area where burial rights still exist are specifically excluded from the scheduling.

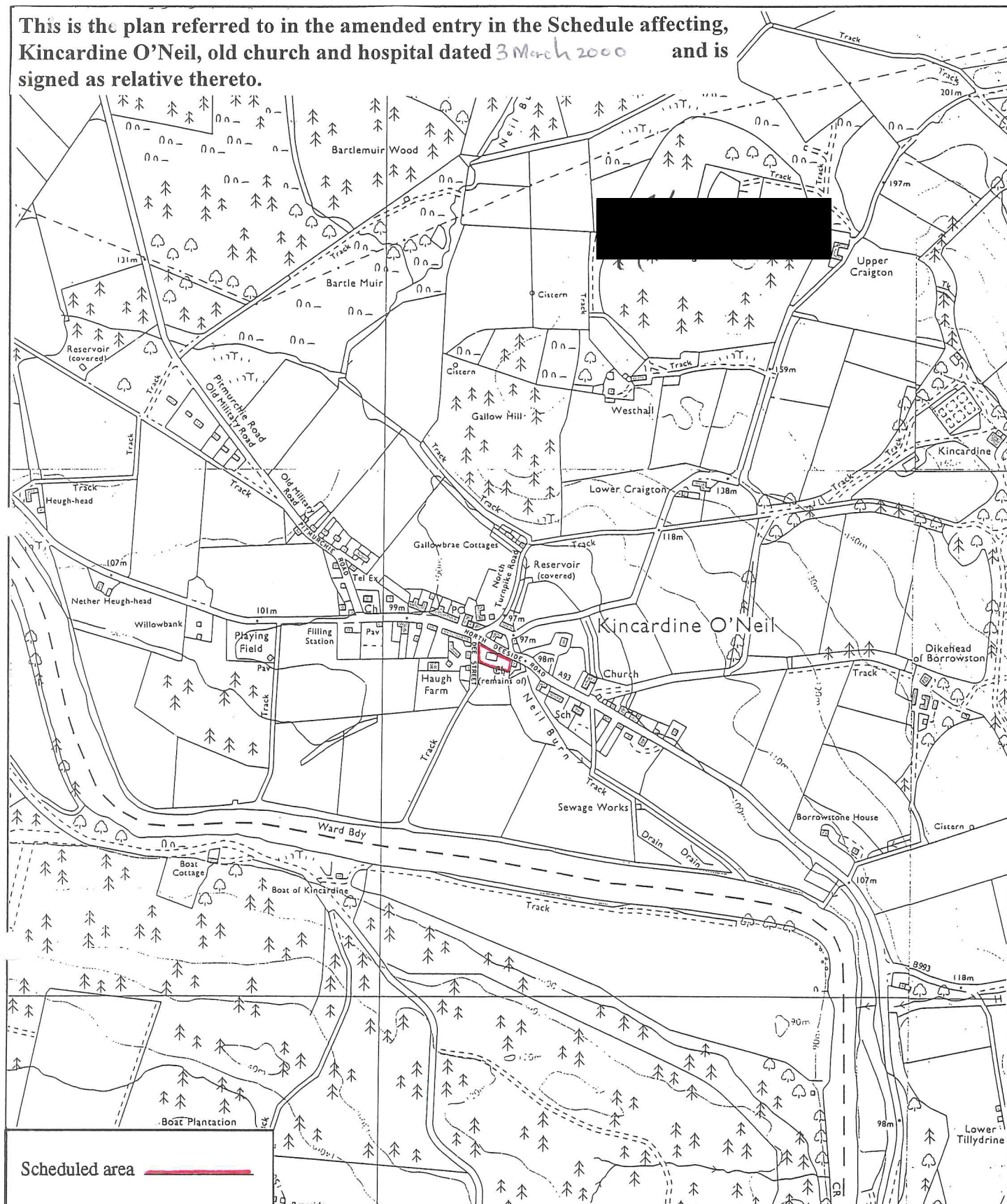

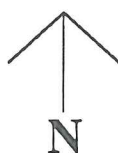

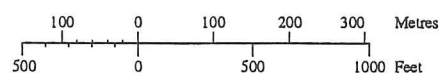
Kincardine O'Neil, old church and hospital

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

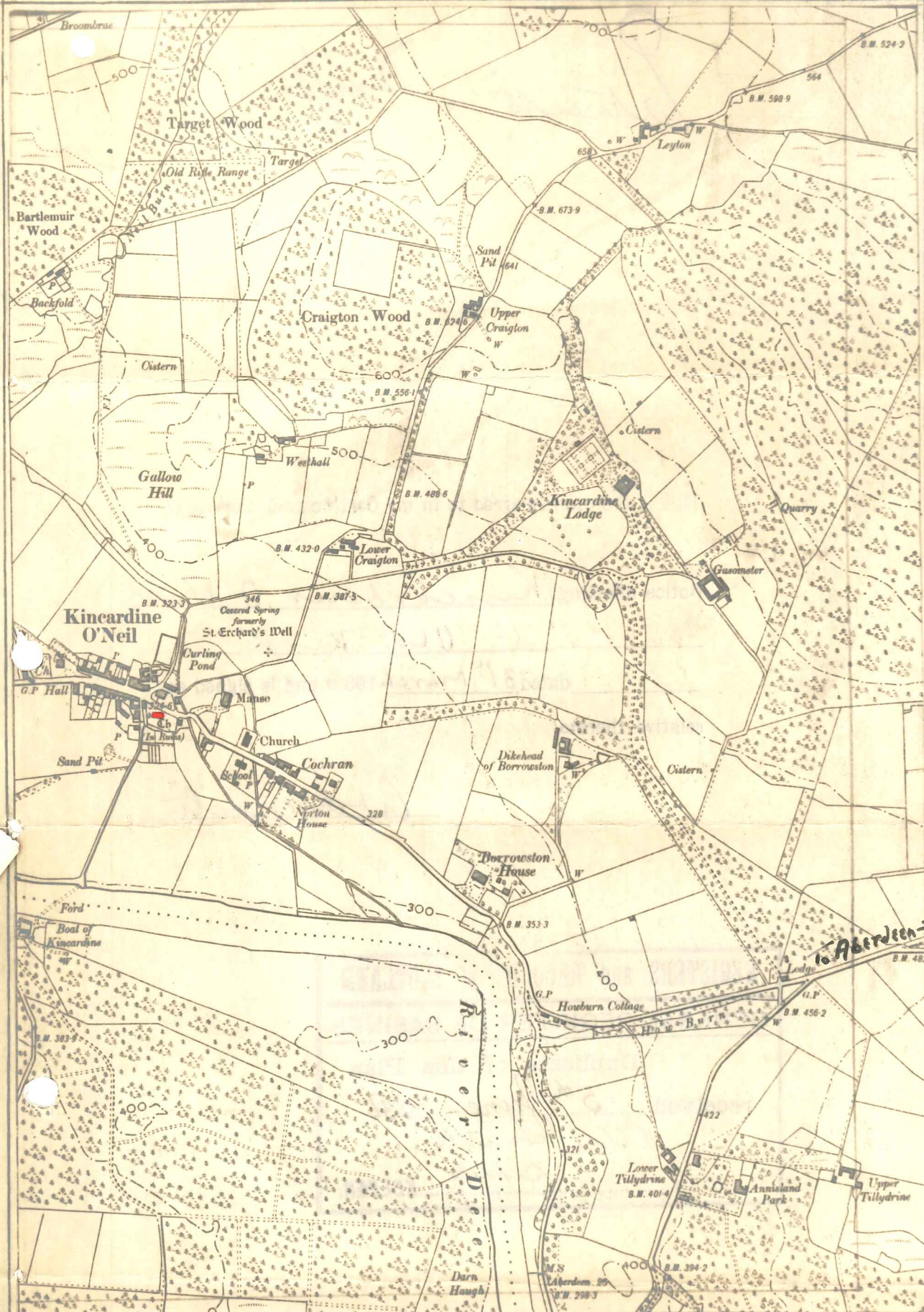
